

Continental Ballet Student Agreement 2018-19

Welcome to Continental Ballet. We are delighted you have decided to study ballet with us!

Studio Information

Classes run from Tuesday, September 4, 2018 thru June 2019. Enrollment is ongoing, so you may register and join classes at anytime. Summer classes vary each season. New students may take a trial class for level placement, recommended by the instructor.

The studio calendar and updates are distributed to student families by email. As the schedule may be subject to change at any time, we will attempt to promptly notify families if changes occur. Parents are welcome to observe their student in the studio classes during Observation Week.

Class Preparation

Students should not be late for class. We encourage students to arrive 10 to 15 minutes prior to their class start time. We ask that students/ parents inform their instructor or the office in advance if you will not be attending a class. Please follow the dress code accordingly, including hair guidelines.

Class Dress Code

Hair must be pulled back into a bun, and short hair must be secured away from the face. Boys must wear black tights, black shoes, and white tee shirts. Dress codes must be observed or students may not be allowed into class. Each ballet level has a designated leotard color. Please check with our Registrar or your instructor if you have questions.

Tuition Payments

The applicant agrees to pay FULL tuition the first week of each month, June included (total of 10 payments, if starting in September) without being invoiced and acknowledges that there will be a late fee of \$10.00 for payments received after the first week of each month. Tuition is NONREFUNDABLE and cannot be extended to the next session or term. If a student begins classes after the first week of the month, then an individual class fee must be paid per class until the next month begins.

Students may not be allowed into class if tuition payments are more than 1 month behind. Holidays and snow days are covered by months that have 5 classes in them; make-up classes are not offered.

Student Recital

Our Spring Student Recital is held the third Thursday of June at 7:00 PM at the Bloomington Center for the Arts. The Dress Rehearsal and Photos are the day before the show on Wednesday. Students pay for their recital costumes. The costume fee is due in early spring when we place the costume orders. Students are not required to participate in the recital, as classes will continue to work on ballet technique in addition to learning a recital dance. Please plan ahead and let your instructor know by April 1 if you elect not to participate in the recital.
