Notice and Agreement

The applicant, and, if appropriate the applicant's parent and/or guardian acknowledges that there does exist in the study of dance some risk of injury. It is the applicant's responsibility to fully disclose to his or her instructor(s) any circumstances which might place the applicant in jeopardy of injury.

The applicant, as additional consideration for the student's instruction, hereby releases Continental Ballet Company and its instructors and staff, from liability for injuries to the person or property of the student, which may occur while participating in its activities. The undersigned further agrees to indemnify Continental Ballet Company for any damages, including attorney's fees, in the event any claims are asserted against it arising from the student's participation in its activities.

Tuition Payments

- The applicant agrees to pay FULL tuition the first week of each month (June included) without being invoiced and acknowledges that there will be a late fee of \$10 for payments received after the first week of each month.
- Tuition is never pro-rated. Students starting mid-month or later have the option of paying either for the full month or the single class rate until the next month begins.
- Classes are discounted only when paying for the full month (For Example: \$50/month divided by 4 classes = \$12.50 per class. However, that discounted rate is only given when paying for a full month. Single classes are either \$15 or \$25)
- Tuition is NONREFUNDABLE and cannot be extended to the next session or term.

Students will not be allowed into class if tuition payments are more than 2 months behind. Holidays and snow days are covered by months that have 5 classes in them; make-up classes are not offered. For inclement weather, we follow the Bloomington Public Schools District closings.

Studio Information

Classes run from September through June. Studio etiquette and policies are posted on our website. Please check your email inbox for CBC updates/notes. For the annual spring student recital held mid-June, Pre-Ballet--Ballet 6 Student participation is encouraged, not required. Depending on the attire selected by instructors for each class performing, Costumes may range from \$30 to \$55 each (student fee per costume) if they are ordered from a costume company.

- **Pre-Ballet** (45 minute classes) \$45/month
- **Ballet 1** (1 hour class) \$50/month
- **Ballet 2** (1 hour class) \$50/month
- **Ballet 3** (1 hour class) \$50/month
- **Ballet 4** (1 hour class) \$50/month
- **Ballet 5** (1.5 hour and 2 hour classes)
 - Two classes per week Required \$96/month
- **Ballet 6** (1.5 hour and 2 hour classes)
 - Three classes per week \$120/month
 - Four classes per week \$150/month
- **Teen Ballet** (1 hour classes) \$50/month

Single Class Rates

1 hour classes: \$15 per individual class

1.5 hour and 2 hour classes: \$25 per individual class

TUITION POLICY

- Tuition must be paid in full by the 10th of the month (a \$10 late fee will be applied after).
- Tuition is never pro-rated.
- Students starting mid-month or later have the option of paying for the full month or paying the single class rate until the next month begins.
- Classes are discounted only when paying for the full month
(Example: \$50/month divided by 4 classes = \$12.50 per class. However, that discounted rate is only given when paying for a full month. Individual classes are either \$15 or \$25)
